Conditions of purchase and event attendance

1. **Ticket Refunds.** There are no refunds. The Festival will take place regardless of the weather.

Treat your ticket as carefully as cash. This is your proof of purchase. If you arrive without your pre-issued Ticket, you may be charged again at the Ticket Office.

2. **Ticket Wristband Exchange**

You will need to present your ticket voucher to exchange for a coloured wristband at the Festival, which is located at the entrance to the Cobargo Showground on the Bermagui Cobargo Road. Just follow the signs.

3. **Please ensure you have your tickets with you** to present at the ticket office to obtain a wristband.

Valid Tickets: Festival Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any person who,

- cannot verify a ticket purchase - a credit card or license will suffice
- cannot produce a valid e-ticket
- presents an e-ticket that has been purchased or obtained through an unauthorised source or by illegal means or duplicated
- ticket orders will be cancelled if cheques are dishonoured or credit card funds are unavailable.

4. **Camping** fees need to be paid before you can enter the showground. Camping is for weekend ticket holders only

- for those not needing to camp there is a free day car parking area
- campers under 18 must be accompanied and supervised by a camping parent
- camper vans, caravans, motor homes are welcome and to be positioned in designated area. Please ask at the ticket office.

5. There will be NO PUBLIC ACCESS to the festival site (including camping area), except for authorised personnel, prior to Thursday 24th February, 2011.

6. **Youth Policy:** Youth tickets may only be purchased with an adult ticket applicant / ticket-holder. Youth ticket holders must be accompanied by a parent or a responsible adult. Proof of age ID may be requested when collecting a youth wristband. Age must be under 18 on last day of festival

7. **Ticket Office Hours:**

Thursday 23rd February 9.30am to 8pm Friday 24th February 8.00am to 10.30pm

Saturday 25th February 8.00am to 10.30pm Sunday 26th February 9.00am to 6.00pm

8. The festival, the bar and session area will be open at 1.00 pm on Friday 25th and the festival program commences at 2 pm . The Program will be available on our website closer to the festival. www.cobargofolkfestival.com.

9. **NO ALCOHOL** to be brought into the Festival. The area is a Licensed Venue. Proof of age for youth in licensed areas may be requested by staff.

10. **NO PETS** allowed in Camping or Festival grounds (Conditions of Insurers)

11. **Footwear** must be worn at all times

12. **Offensive Behaviour**

The Festival has the right to refuse entry or evict patrons who behave in a manner that is inappropriate, offensive to others, dangerous or illegal.

13. The Festival reserves the right to vary the advertised artists and/or program.

Festival organisers are all volunteers. Please assist where possible.
